Benefits to Adult Family Living

The Adult Family Living program offers guidance and financial support to caregivers, helping them to succeed in providing the best care possible. Caregivers receive expert advice on managing daily tasks and a monthly tax-free stipend that compensates for the care and assistance they give to an older family member or friend.

- Allows older adults to age in place, as an alternative to nursing home placement
- Provides financial support to caregivers, helping to alleviate stress in managing expenditures
- Offers guidance and resources to caregivers, as part of a care management plan
- · Offers daycare as an additional covered option

Requirements for Caregivers

- Must be 21 years of age or older
- · Can be a family relative or friend, but not a spouse
- Must reside in the home of the recipient and be able to have 24-hour response capability to meet the needs of participant
- Must provide supervision and meet cognitive and behavioral needs of participant
- · Must assist with activities of daily living
- Must work through an intermediary agency, such as ElderHouse

Requirements for Seniors

- Must be 65 years of age or older
- · Need assistance with activities of daily living
- Must meet financial guidelines (Older adult must qualify for CHCPE as a Medicaid or Category 2 recipient)
